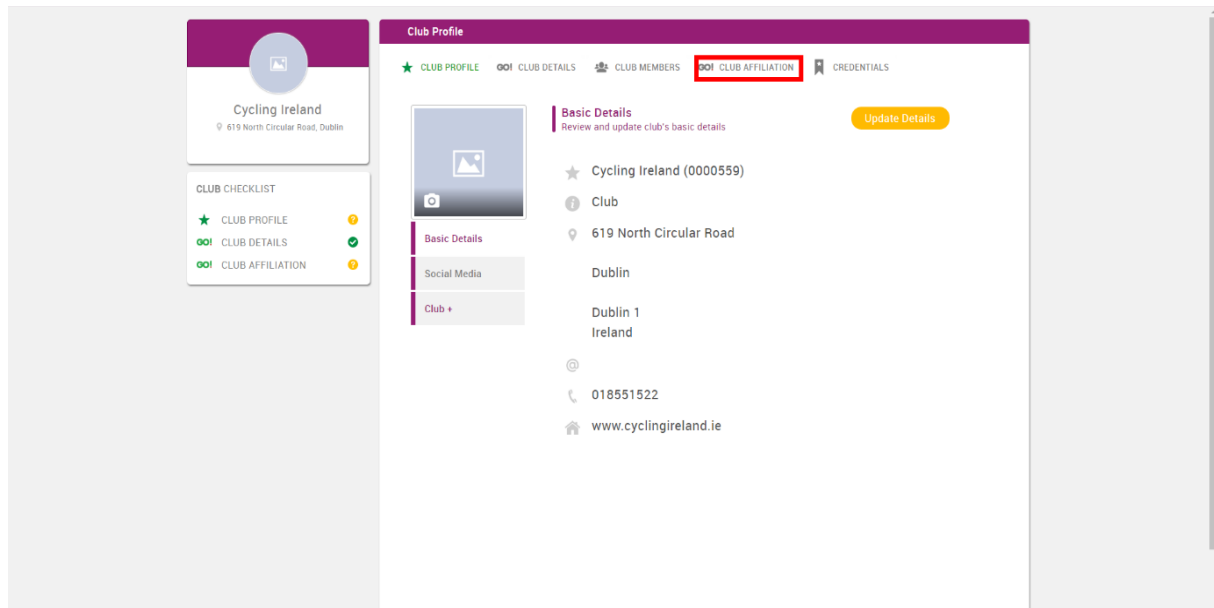
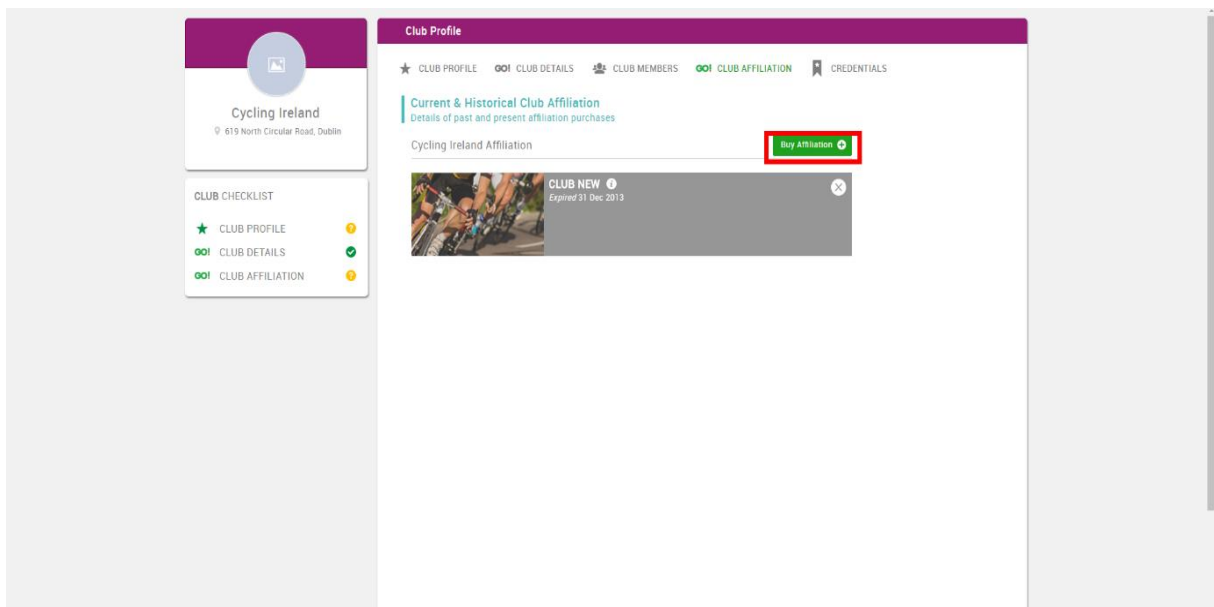


Q: Club Affiliation

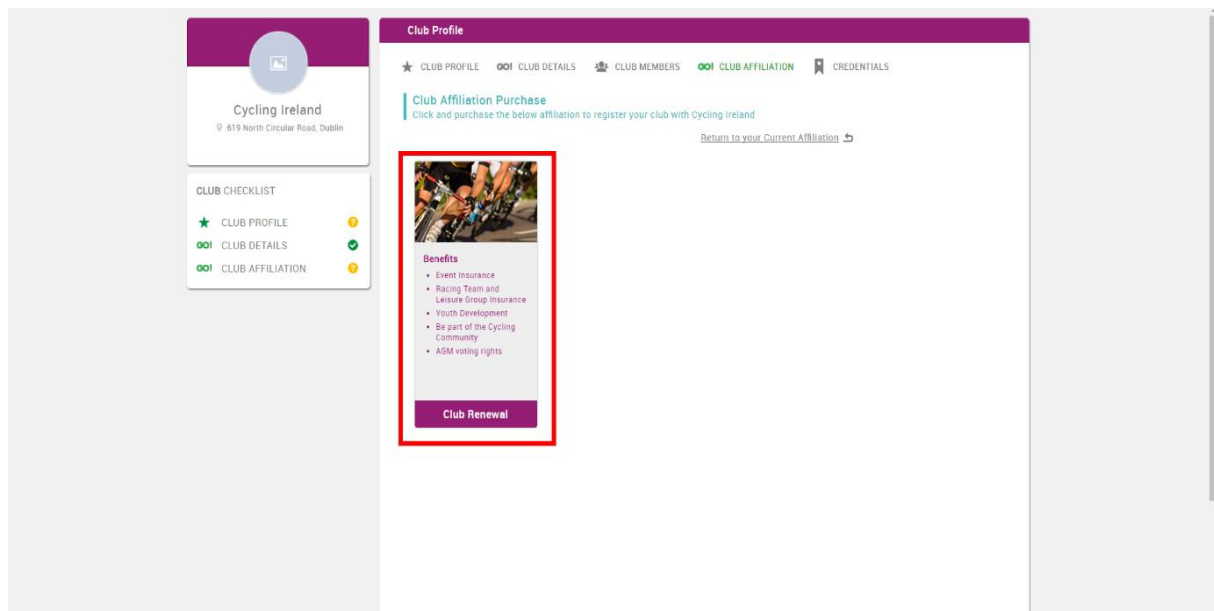
1. From the club profile page, click Club Affiliation.



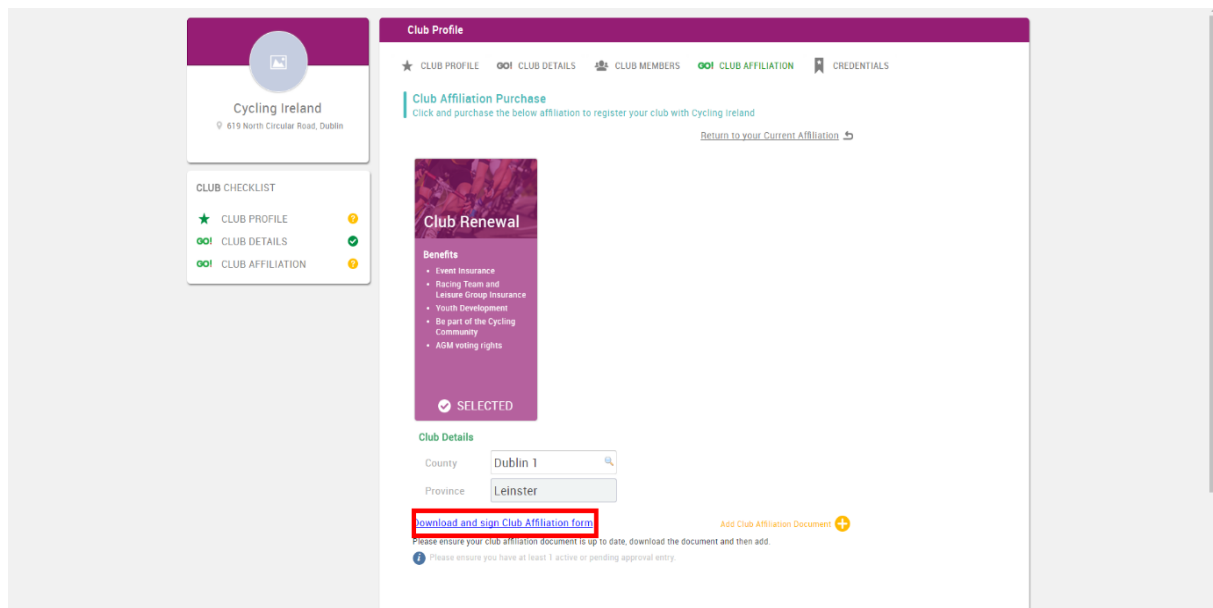
2. From the club affiliation page, click Buy Affiliation.
